He has completed the running.



Structure

o S+ has/have + V3

Example

o She **has written** an essay.



Structure

o S+ has/have + not + V3

Example

o She **has not written** an essay.



Structure

o Has/have+ S + V3 +... ?

Example

o **Has she written** an essay?

USAGE

How long?

The work that has recently been completed.

Time period that has not finished.

To describe the specific moment of time.

EXAMPLES

I **have been** at work **for** six hours.

He **has just** **cooked** the meal.

She **has drunk** two cups of tea **today**.

We **have lived** in this house **since** 2015.

I've been working (that's why I'm tired).

UNFINISHED

HOW LONG

I've been living in London for two years.
She's been working here since 2004.

Use with: since 2010, since July, for ten years, for three days.

TEMPORARY SITUATIONS

I've been going to the gym a lot recently.

Use with: recently.
