Structure **IF + Simple Present, Simple Future**
(S + will/won't + V(bare form))

Usage To talk about possibilities in the present or in the future

- Examples**
- If it **rains**, I **will stay** at home.
 - If I **wake** up late, I **will miss** the bus.
 - And, if it's sunny, we'll **go** to the park.
 - If Juan **leaves**, Paula **will be** sad.
 - If I **find** your email, I **will send** you the picture.
 - If you **study** hard, you **will pass** your exams.

If	she studies hard,	she will pass the exam.

RESULT	IF	CONDITION
WILL/WON'T+BASE VERB		PRESENT SIMPLE
She will pass the exam	if	she studies hard.

We use the first conditional when there is a **real possibility** that this condition will happen in the future. Remember the **S** for the 3rd person singular (present simple). If it **rains**, I won't go to the beach.

The First Conditional

(if + simple present + will + verb)

(will + verb + if + simple present)

We use *first conditional* when talking about **possible future events**. The if clause is in the **simple present** and the main clause is in the **simple future**.

- If he **catches** a fish, he **will be** happy. Or:
- He **will be** happy if he **catches** a fish.

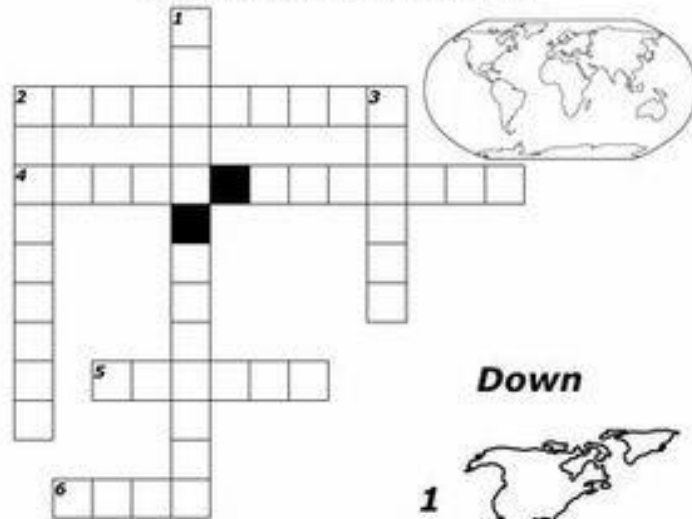

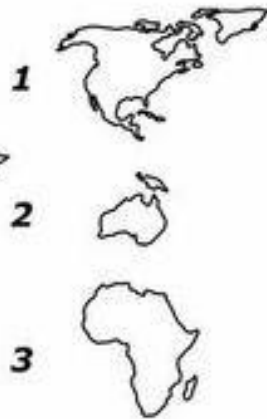

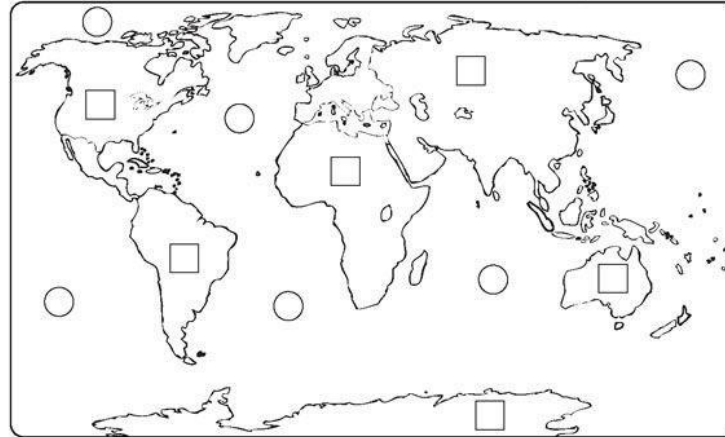

The first conditional is a structure used for talking about possibilities in the present or in the future.

Describes possible things, which could easily come true.



The first conditional has the **present simple** after 'if', then the future simple in the other clause:

if + present simple , ... will + infinitive



EXAMPLES



FIRST CONDITIONAL



Positive WILL
Negative WON`T

If it rains, I won't go to the park.

If I study today, I will go to the party tonight.

She will be late if the train is delayed.
